

DevInfo : How to Get Device Information File

To find the reason for the problem you have, we need to know about your device information like kernel version, status of each hardware component..., etc.

You can simply let us know the information by the 'DevInfo' file.

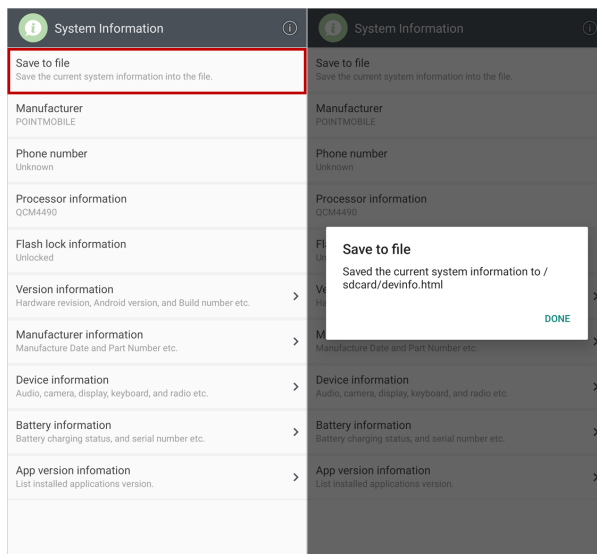
Execute EmKit . You can find the EmKit on the home screen usually.

Navigate to System Information Menu

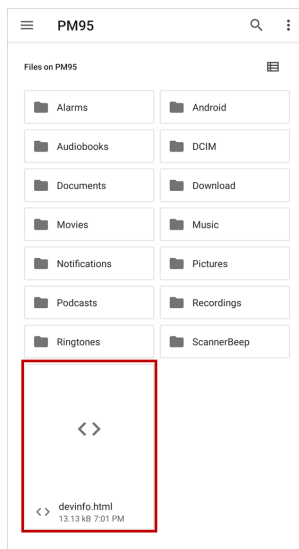
Tap 'Save to file'. the system makes the file automatically.

Execute **FileExplorer** and go to the root folder of internal storage.

You can find **devinfo.html** file.

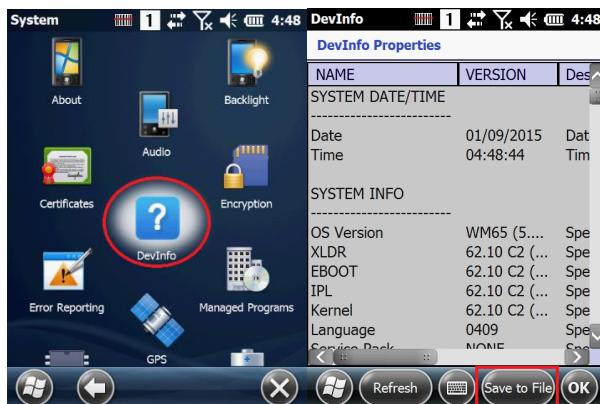

Go to **Start > Settings > System**



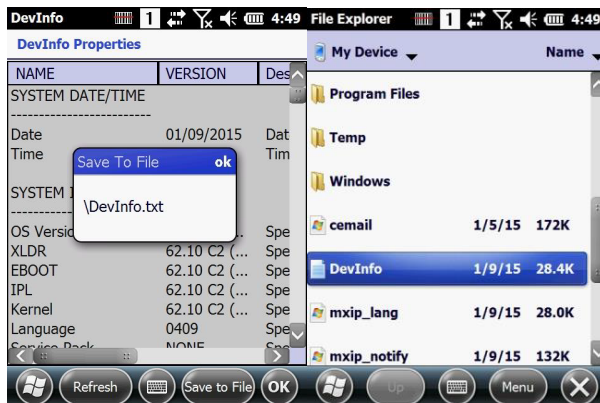

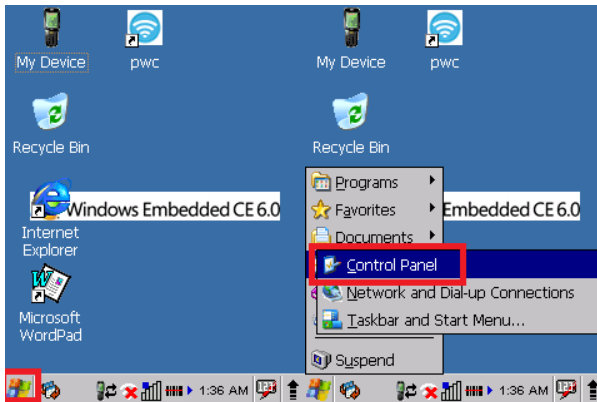
You can find the DevInfo file in the root directory of the device storage as TXT format



Win CE

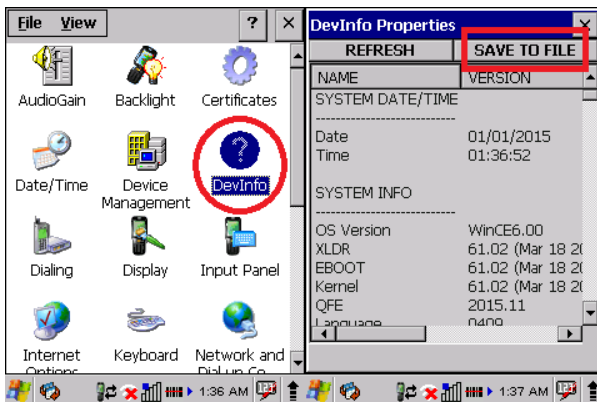

Go to **Start > Settings > Control Panel**



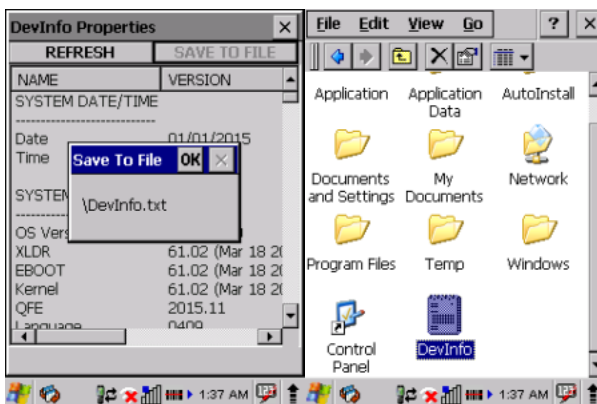
