Key Macro is used to map a certain physical key to any customized key sequence (key combination). It is especially for the Point Mobile devices with keypad.

This can be used in the following cases:

- When you need to enter same key patterns continuously
- When you need to enter complex key combination at once
- When you want to access a certain web-site without entering its address one by one.


